Resolution No. USET 2002:020

SUPPORT OF THE 2003 NATIONAL INDIAN EDUCATION ASSOCIATION CONVENTION

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the action taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Education Committee is in support of the 2003 National Indian Education Association (NIEA) Convention, being held in Greensboro, NC, November 2-5, 2003; and
- WHEREAS, NIEA Conventions have not often been located east of the Mississippi; and
- WHEREAS, the mission and goals of the NIEA are in support of traditional native cultures and values; and
- WHEREAS, the NIEA enables native students to become contributing members of their communities; and
- WHEREAS, the NIEA promotes native control of educational institutions; and
- WHEREAS, the NIEA seeks to improve educational opportunities and resources for American Indians and Alaska Natives throughout the United States; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors encourages and endorses the location of the 2003 NIEA Convention in Greensboro, NC.
