Resolution No. USET 2002:023

EPA TRIBAL ENVIRONMENTAL PROGRAMS

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribe's leadership; and WHEREAS, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) is responsible for the environment, health and safety of all peoples within the external boundaries of the United States; and WHEREAS, the States have received this protection since the early 1970s and have progressed in developing the environmental infrastructure and programs within their states having received extraordinary support of EPA; and WHEREAS, EPA has only in the last decade commenced to include Indian tribes, their reservations and trust lands; and WHEREAS, tribes have been subjected to the most serious environmental conditions over these years while the tribes still lack significant advancement in comparison to states in environmental infrastructure and program support; and WHEREAS, the budget has been placed in question due to terrorism and actions against America, our home; and WHEREAS, the tribes support the President's actions taken in regard to protecting America and all peoples; and WHEREAS, tribes have a magnificent and truly great history in defending America, having members in all the armed forces; and WHEREAS, many tribal veterans are members of our tribal governments and leadership; and WHEREAS, our environmental programs have evolved into efficient and effective tribal departments of environmental protection; therefore, be it
- **RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors requests that President Bush, Administrator Whitman and other Departments and Agencies, and, the Congress to protect the Indian programs and respective budgets in the future, and be it further
- **RESOLVED** that all tribal programs serve as our basic governmental support in protecting our families and members.
