Resolution No. USET 2002:026

SUPPORT FOR THE ELECTION OF BUFORD ROLIN TO SERVE AS THE CHAIRPERSON OF THE NATIONAL INDIAN HEALTH BOARD (NIHB)

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors is comprised of delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the National Indian Health Board (NIHB) will be conducting elections on November 6-8, 2001 in Denver, Colorado for their Board of Directors; and
- WHEREAS, Buford Rolin's commitment and concerns of the health of Indian people consistently match those of the USET member Tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the USET Board of Directors recognizes the fact the Mr. Rolin is a strong advocate for the health of American Indian/Alaska Native people as evidenced in his service as Vice-Chairman of the USET Health Committee and service on many workgroups involving the health of AI/AN people; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Rolin has consistently demonstrated his support of the USET Board of Directors and USET Health Committee by attending each meeting himself or appointing one or more of his staff to speak on his behalf; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors supports the election of Buford Rolin as Chairperson of the National Indian Health Board.
