USET Resolution No. 2002:044

RISK MANAGEMENT INCLUSION TO TRIBAL EMERGENCY SERVICES COMMITTEE

- WHEREAS,** United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS,** the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS,** Risk Management is a means to utilize points of contact with Insurance Carriers that would provide a variety of services for General Liability and Casualty Insurance; and
- WHEREAS,** these services would include loss prevention services, business interruption coverage, vital equipment replacement for speedy recovery, and promote on the job safety measures/programs to reduce employee injury; and
- WHEREAS,** Risk Management plays an important role in Tribal Asset Protection that includes personal property and business ventures; and
- WHEREAS,** the USET Tribal Emergency Services Committee agreed to submit a recommendation to the USET Board of Directors that each Tribe promote Risk Management and that Risk Management representatives be included in the Tribal Emergency Services Committee; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors supports this recommendation to promote Risk Management and to include Risk Management Issues as part of the Tribal Emergency Services Committee.
