USET Resolution No. 2002:057

APPOINTMENT OF REPRESENTATIVES TO THE NEGOTIATED RULEMAKING COMMITTEE

- WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS, the Tribes represented by USET have a direct and vested interest in the reauthorization of the Native American Housing and Self Determination Act (NAHASDA); and
- WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has called for and will accept through June 15, 2002 nominations for participants to the NAHASDA Negotiated Rulemaking Committee; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors hereby appoints Eddie Tullis, Chairman of the Poarch Band of Creek Indians, Rosilyn Brown Barnett, of the Narragansett Tribe, Joel Frank, of the Seminole Tribe of Florida, and Beasley Denson, of the Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians as representatives for Region One to the NAHASDA Negotiated Rulemaking Committee.
