USET Resolution No. 2003:104

EASTERN REGIONAL RESIDUALS

- WHEREAS,** United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and
- WHEREAS,** the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS,** in accordance with 25 CFR Part 1000.95 (a), the Bureau of Indian Affairs (BIA) central and regional offices are required to compile a single document for distribution to the tribes each year that contains all the residual/non-residual tribal shares information of that respective office; and
- WHEREAS,** the BIA/ERO has not been providing the annual report in the past and is currently in violation of the federal regulation; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors does hereby request the Bureau of Indian Affairs Eastern Regional Office to prepare a report no later than September 1, 2003 containing information on the residual/non-residual tribal shares that can be contracted or compacted.
