WHEREAS. the Indian Reservation Roads (IRR) Negotiated Rule Making Committee has only two

primary Eastern Region representatives and currently has two Eastern Region alternate

vacancies; and

the Transportation Committee recommends and seeks endorsement of the following WHEREAS,

individuals: Richard Doyle, Passamaquoddy Tribe- Pleasant Point and Tim Tubby, Mississippi Band of Choctaw Indians for nomination as Eastern Region alternates to the

IRR Negotiated Rulemaking Committee; and

that the USET Board of Directors approves and endorses the specified individuals to serve RESOLVED

as alternates on the IRR Negotiated Rulemaking Committee for the Eastern Region.
