USET Resolution No. 2003:075

INCREASED APPROPRIATION LEVELS FOR INDIAN HOUSING BLOCK GRANT

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and

WHEREAS, USET has expert knowledge of the funding needs of NAHASDA programs; and

WHEREAS, USET knows that current funding levels do not meet present needs; therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors has determined the FY2003 appropriations level for the Indian Housing Block Grant (IHBG) be sustained at 1.0 billion dollars, and; be it further

RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors determines that the FY 2004 appropriation level for IHBG be increased to 1.1 billion dollars.

CERTIFICATION

This resolution was duly passed at the USET Impact Week Meeting, at which a quorum was present, in Arlington, VA, Thursday, February 6, 2003.


