USET Resolution No. 2004:024

SUPPORT FOR CONTINUED FUNDING FOR TRAINING AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE FOR THE NATIONAL AMERICAN INDIAN HOUSING COUNCIL

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and

WHEREAS, the National American Indian Housing Council (NAIHC) is the primary advocacy agency for Tribal housing entities; and

WHEREAS, the USET tribes have found the training and technical assistance provided by NAIHC to be exemplary and of significant value to the on-going development of housing staff, the education of tribal governments and the education of the tribal members serviced by the respective housing entities; and

WHEREAS, the USET tribes have not been satisfied with the training provided by the Department of Housing and Urban Development for lack of adaptation to the specific needs of Indian housing; and

WHEREAS, the USET tribes feel more comfortable with the training and technical assistance being provided by a non-regulatory agency; therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors recommends that the NAHASDA training and technical assistance budget enacted in FY 2004 be continued for the FY 2005 budget; and, be it further

RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors recommends that this budget line item be considered a permanent part of the NAHASDA budget.
