USET Resolution No. 2004:030

SUPPORT FOR THE INCLUSION OF NAHASDA BUILT HOMES IN THE CURRENT ASSISTED STOCK FOR THE PURPOSES OF FUNDING ADDITIONAL MAINTENANCE

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and

WHEREAS, the purpose is to provide affordable housing to low-income American Indian/Alaskan Native families; and

WHEREAS, homes built with Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act (NAHASDA) funds are not counted as part of the current assisted housing stock of the Tribe/Tribally Designated Housing Entities; and

WHEREAS, no maintenance funding is provided for NAHASDA built homes; therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors supports the inclusion of NAHASDA built homes in the Current Assisted Stock in order to allow future funding to be used on the maintenance of NAHASDA built homes.
