USET Resolution No. 2004:076

SUPPORT FOR INDIAN HEALTH SERVICE SANITATION FACILITIES CONSTRUCTION PROGRAM FUNDING POLICY REVIEW

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member tribes' leadership; and

WHEREAS, Tribes receive funds from Indian Health Service (IHS) for the Sanitation Facilities Construction Program (SFCP) to provide for the installation of safe and sanitary facilities for tribal members; and

WHEREAS, previous policies written by IHS provided a specific cost ceiling on the installation of individual systems; and

WHEREAS, IHS is currently creating a systematic formula to allocate the SFC funds in a fair and equitable manner among the Tribes it serves; therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors hereby requests that the new policy being drafted for the SFCP allow for tribes to exercise self-determination in determining the spending limits on individual projects.
