USET Resolution No. 2005:017

PENOBSCOT NATION GOVERNMENTAL Rx PARTNERSHIP

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized Tribes; and the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each WHEREAS. member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and the Penobscot Nation is a member-in-good-standing of USET; and WHEREAS, WHEREAS. the Penobscot Nation and the State of Maine have entered into a Governmental Rx Partnership for the purpose of importing prescription drugs from Canada; and the partnership ensures equitable access to all persons, especially the elderly and needy WHEREAS. for much needed pharmaceuticals; and John Baldacci, Governor of the State of Maine, has requested a waiver from the Secretary WHEREAS. of Health and Human Services for importation of pharmaceuticals, to be administrated and wholesaled by the Penobscot Nation; and the Congressional Delegation of Maine, U.S. Senators Snowe and Collins, and U.S. WHEREAS, Representatives Allen and Michaud sent a joint letter supporting the Governmental Rx Partnership project; and WHEREAS. Secretary Thompson, Under-Secretary Claude Allen and Regional Administrator Brian Cresta of HHS have been delaying a decision for issuing the waiver to Maine and the Penobscot Nation; and the U.S. Government has failed to address these concerns despite HHS public comments WHEREAS. in favor of importation of prescription drugs; and the Penobscot Nation and the State of Maine have responded to the concerns of the WHEREAS, people in need through a Governmental Rx Partnership; therefore, be it that the USET Board of Directors supports the Penobscot Nation and the State of Maine RESOLVED Governmental Rx Partnership and call for the Secretary of Health and Human Services to issue the much needed waiver; and, be it further that the respective Congressional Committees and sub-committees be notified and RESOLVED requested to intervene on behalf of this partnership and efforts being undertaken by the Penobscot Nation and the State of Maine; and, be it further RESOLVED that the White House be called upon to curtail any further delays of the HHS Administration and on behalf of the Penobscot Nation and the State of Maine to
