
USET Resolution No. 2005:030


FUNDING TO FURTHER THE TRIBAL COLLEGE INITIATIVE

- WHEREAS,** United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized Tribes; and
- WHEREAS,** the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS,** the USET Education Committee has recently passed Resolutions No. 2004:008 and No. 2004:041 in support of the development and pursuit of establishing a USET inter-tribal college east of the Mississippi; and
- WHEREAS,** the USET Board of Directors supports the work of the USET Education Committee and the USET Inter-Tribal College ad hoc work group; and
- WHEREAS,** the USET Board of Directors instructs the USET Staff, Education Committee and the USET Inter-Tribal College ad hoc work group to continue cooperative efforts to move forward with the next steps of establishing an inter-tribal college in the East; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors authorizes the USET Executive Director to research funding opportunities in cooperation with the Education Committee that would support and further the USET inter-tribal college initiative.
