USET Resolution No. 2005:030

FUNDING TO FURTHER THE TRIBAL COLLEGE INITIATIVE

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and

WHEREAS, the USET Education Committee has recently passed Resolutions No. 2004:008 and No. 2004:041 in support of the development and pursuit of establishing a USET inter-tribal college east of the Mississippi; and

WHEREAS, the USET Board of Directors supports the work of the USET Education Committee and the USET Inter-Tribal College ad hoc work group; and

WHEREAS, the USET Board of Directors instructs the USET Staff, Education Committee and the USET Inter-Tribal College ad hoc work group to continue cooperative efforts to move forward with the next steps of establishing an inter-tribal college in the East; therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors authorizes the USET Executive Director to research funding opportunities in cooperation with the Education Committee that would support and further the USET inter-tribal college initiative.
