USET Resolution No. 2005:040

SUPPORT FOR ASSURANCE THAT THE LEVEL OF APPROPRIATIONS UNDER THE NATIVE AMERICAN HOUSING AND SELF-DETERMINATION ACT BE KEPT AT A LEVEL CONSISTENT WITH CONSTANT INFLATION AND INCREASED COSTS OF LIVING

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and

WHEREAS, the needs and issues affecting the USET member Tribes are as vast and diverse as the geographic locations that the tribes occupy; and

WHEREAS, USET member Tribes depend on annual funding with which to keep low income housing affordable to all of its members; therefore, it is vitally important that the annual appropriation levels are consistent with real increases in the cost of living and inflation; and

WHEREAS, this unrealistic and capricious decrease in appropriations and the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) funding is not in keeping with the fiduciary responsibility espoused by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and the U.S. Government, and severely affects the ability of tribal housing entities to fulfill their task of providing safe, affordable and decent housing for its members; therefore, be it

RESOLVED that the USET Board of Directors requests the assurance of HUD that the NAHASDA appropriations will remain consistent with the ongoing rate of inflation and the real costs of living.
