USET Resolution No. 2005:050

SUPPORT FOR REGIONAL GPRA/PART TRAINING

- WHEREAS,** United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized Tribes; and
- WHEREAS,** the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and
- WHEREAS,** the Bureau of Indian Affairs has cancelled scheduled regional training on Government Performance Results Act (GPRA), Program Assessment Rating Tool (PART) and Department of the Interior Strategic Planning, as well as has suggested reducing the four day training into a one day session; and
- WHEREAS,** the Eastern Region Tribes have identified that this training is crucial as the tribes must be knowledgeable about GPRA, PART, and the DOI's Strategic Plan and how these topics relate to BIA funding levels and the delivery of programs, services, functions, and activities (PSFA); therefore, be it
- RESOLVED** that the USET Board of Directors calls upon the Bureau of Indian Affairs Central Office to reschedule the Eastern Region's training on Government Performance Results Act, Program Assessment Rating Tool and Strategic Planning, as well as schedule the full four day session by October 1, 2005.
