USET Resolution No. 2007:017

THE IROQUOIS NATIONS AND THE STATE OF NEW YORK

United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization WHEREAS, comprising twenty-four (24) federally recognized Tribes; and

the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each WHEREAS, member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and

several USET members-the Cayuga Nation, Seneca Nation of Indians, St. Regis WHEREAS, Mohawk Tribe and Oneida Indian Nation—are members of the Iroquois Confederacy and are situated within the boundaries of the State of New York; and

the citizens of the State of New York recently elected the Honorable Elliot Spitzer to the WHEREAS, Office of the Governor, and

Governor Spitzer has announced his plans to address certain issues concerning the WHEREAS, frequeis Nations, such as the taxation of automotive fuels and tobacco products; therefore,

the USET Board of Directors hereby congratulates Governor Spitzer on his election to the RESOLVED, Office of Governor of the Great State of New York; and be it further

RESOLVED. the USET Board of Directors urge Mr. Spitzer, as he seeks to resolve tax and other issues with the Iroquois Nations within New York, to respect the sovereignty of those nations, to commit to work with the frequeis Nations on a government-to-government basis, and to pursue bilateral negotiated solutions with each nation with respect to any disagreements that may arise during his administration.
