WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes'

leadership; and

WHEREAS, the USET Board of Directors has established and supports the efforts of the USET Water

and Wastewater Certification Board (USET Certification Board); and

WHEREAS, two positions on the USET Certification Board are now vacant; and

WHEREAS, USET requested nominations of individuals who are qualified to serve from all member

Tribes; and

WHEREAS, Gene Wayne Francis, Passamaquoddy Tribe Pleasant Point, and Stan Bailey,

Narragansett Indian Tribe, have been nominated to serve on the USET Certification Board for the term specified in Section 1-Article V of the USET Certification Board Bylaws; and

WHEREAS, the USET Natural Resources Committee has reviewed and approves the appointment of

the nominated individuals to the USET Certification Board; therefore, be it

RESOLVED the USET Board of Directors accepts and approves the individuals nominated to serve for

the specified term on the USET Water and Wastewater Certification Board.
