## SUPPORT FOR FUNDING OF NATIVE AMERICAN HOUSING ASSISTANCE AND SELF-DETERMINATION ACT

United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization WHEREAS, comprised of twenty-four (24) federally recognized Tribes; and

the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each WHEREAS,

member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and

Congress recognized the need for housing assistance and economic development in WHEREAS,

Indian Country when they passed the Native American Housing Assistance and Self

Determination Act of 1996 (NAHASDA) as amended; and

the need for housing and economic development continues to grow and NAHASDA WHEREAS,

continues to be funded at diminishing levels; and

Indian Housing Block Grant Programs are significantly under funded; and therefore be it WHEREAS.

the USET Board of Directors supports an appropriation that will include an inflation factor RESOLVED

of 3.4% for fiscal year 2008 to help offset the rapidly increasing costs of maintaining the current assisted stock and offsetting the increased costs of construction, and be it further

all USET Tribes and Tribally Designated Housing Entities request an increase of funding RESOLVED

from the Congress and Senate for the funding period 2008 from \$625,680,000 to one (1) Billion Dollars to provide affordable, safe, sanitary housing, and development.
