USET Resolution No. 2008:024

FUNDING FOR THE NATIONAL AMERICAN INDIAN HOUSING COUNCIL'S TRAINING AND TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-five (25) federally recognized Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and

WHEREAS, the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act (NAHASDA) provides in Section 703 that funding be provided to national organizations representing Native American housing interests to provide training and technical assistance; and

WHEREAS, this training and technical assistance is essential to Tribes who provide low income housing for its members through the Indian Housing Block Grant; and

WHEREAS, this training and technical assistance is essential for the USET Tribes and all of Indian Country to allow Tribes to stay in compliance with NAHASDA and to train their staff regarding housing regulations, policies and procedures; and

WHEREAS, the National American Indian Housing Council has historically provided training and technical assistance to Tribes through Section 703 of NAHASDA; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Year 2009 President's Proposed Budget Request does not include any funding to national organizations for training and technical assistance; therefore, be it

RESOLVED the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc. Board of Directors requests that no less than \$4.8 million of the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development budget be appropriated to national organizations for training and technical assistance to Tribes, as well as funding for all ensuing years be labeled as a separate appropriation to national organizations for training and technical assistance; and, be it further

the United South and Eastern Tribes, Inc. Board of Directors supports funding appropriate for training and technical assistance to be provided by the National American Indian Housing Council.
