## USET Resolution No. 2008:035

## SUPPORT FOR THE REAUTHORIZATION OF THE STATE CHILDREN'S HEALTH INSURANCE PLAN

United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization WHEREAS. comprised of twenty-five (25) federally recognized Tribes; and the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each WHEREAS, member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and the USET member Tribes are dedicated and committed to the needs of their members and WHEREAS, the stability and well-being of our Indian children; and the Indian Health Service (IHS) is not adequately funded to cover all health care costs for WHEREAS, Indian Tribes; and a vast majority of Tribal families across Indian Country fall at or below the national poverty WHEREAS, level and can't afford to contribute to health care costs; and the State Children's Health Insurance Program (SCHIP) was added on to the Social WHEREAS. Security Act of 1997 at an amount of \$40 billion dollars for a ten year period and has since provided health insurance coverage to all low income children who are not Medicaid eligible: and there are currently 4 million low income children across the United States (U.S) who have WHEREAS. been enrolled into SCHIP; and the loss of this program would severely impact the health care of children across the WHEREAS, nation, specifically within our Indian communities; and Tribal Governments across the nation are appreciative of the year long extension of WHEREAS. SCHIP that was included in the Medicare, Medicaid and SCHIP Extension Act of 2007 (S.

reauthorizing the SCHIP at a level of \$15 billion for the next five years is needed to cover WHEREAS, all currently enrolled children; however, an increase to \$50 billion per year for the next five years would be needed to cover all eligible children; therefore, be it

the USET Board of Directors supports the reauthorization of the State Children's Health RESOLVED Insurance Program at a level of \$50 billion per year for five years.
