USET Resolution No. 2008:005

APPROVAL OF APPOINTMENTS TO THE USET WATER AND WASTEWATER CERTIFICATION BOARD

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-five (25) federally recognized Tribes; and

WHEREAS, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and

WHEREAS, the USET Board of Directors has established and supports the efforts of the USET Water and Wastewater Certification Board (USET Certification Board); and

WHEREAS, the USET Board of Directors approved USET Water and Wastewater Certification Board members to serve for specified terms according to Bylaws established in USET Resolution 2002:081; and

WHEREAS, three positions on the USET Certification Board are now vacant due to term expiration; and

WHEREAS, USET requested nominations of individuals who are qualified to serve from its member Tribes; and

WHEREAS, Randy Noka, Narragansett Indian Tribe; Tony Darden, Chitimacha Tribe of Louisiana; and Calvin Murphy, First Nations Environmental Consulting, have been nominated and have accepted service on the USET Certification Board for the term specified in Section 1-Article V of the USET Certification Board Bylaws; and

WHEREAS, the USET Natural Resources Committee has reviewed and approved the appointment of the nominated individuals to the USET Certification Board; therefore, be it

RESOLVED the USET Board of Directors accepts and approves the individuals nominated to serve for the specified term on the USET Water and Wastewater Certification Board.
