USET Resolution No. 2008:011

INDIAN RESERVATION ROAD INVENTORY ASSISTANCE

WHEREAS,	United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization
,	comprised of twenty-five (25) federally recognized Tribes; and

WHEREAS,	the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes'
	leadership; and

WHEREAS,	state and county governments have refused, in some cases, to negotiate Memorandum of
	Agreements with USET member Tribes; and

WHEREAS,	the Oklahoma and other Western Tribes have historically included both state and county
	roads, in their entirety, on to their Indian Reservation Roads (IRR) Inventory; and

WHEREAS,	the USET Transportation Committee feels that the USET member Tribes have been unfairly restricted regarding the length of state and county roads that can be included on
	IRR Inventories; and

WHEREAS,	because allocations are based on road inventories more resources would be available if USET member Tribes could include both state and local roads, in their entirety, on IRR Inventories; therefore, be it

	the USET Board of Directors requests that the Bureau of Indian Affairs work with state and county governments to assist member Tribes to include both state and county roads, in
	their entirety, on the Indian Reservation Roads Inventory via the negotiation of
	Memorandum of Agreements.
