USET Resolution No. 2009:025

SUPPORT OF THE FINAL RULE ON SALE AND DISPOSAL OF NATIONAL FOREST SYSTEM TIMBER; SPECIAL FOREST PRODUCTS AND FOREST BOTANICAL PRODUCTS, WITH EXCEPTION

WHEREAS, United South and Eastern Tribes, Incorporated (USET) is an intertribal organization comprised of twenty-five (25) federally recognized Tribes; and

whereas, the actions taken by the USET Board of Directors officially represent the intentions of each member Tribe, as the Board of Directors comprises delegates from the member Tribes' leadership; and

whereas, the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) issued a proposed rule on the Sale and Disposal of National Forest System Timber; Special Forest Products and Forest Botanical Products, published Monday, October 22, 2007 in the Federal Register, Vol. 72, No. 203, page 59496; and

WHEREAS, USET provided comments on the proposed rule on January 22, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the USDA published Notice of Final Rule December 29, 2008 in the Federal Register, Vol. 73, No. 249, page 79367 to become effective January 28, 2009; and

WHEREAS the Final Rule has been delayed and the comment period has been extended to March 2, 2009; and

whereas, the USET Natural Resources Committee and the USET Culture and Heritage Committee have jointly reviewed the Final Rule and continue to support the comments submitted in January, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources and Culture and Heritage Committees have determined that the Final Rule includes a specific reference to Tribes with special Treaty Rights; and

WHEREAS, this reference discriminates against certain Federally recognized Tribes without special Treaty Rights; therefore, be it

the USET Board of Directors supports the Final Rule on Sale and Disposal of National Forest System Timber; Special Forest Products and Forest Botanical Products, as published December 29, 2008 in the Federal Register, Vol. 73, No. 249, page 79367, with the exception to references made in the rule that distinguish between the Federally recognized Tribes with special Treaty Rights and those Federally recognized Tribes without special Treaty Rights.
